

You can use any stitch/design you wish (20"x80" rectangle is most practical as it can be used as a lap robe as well), and any color. Soft yarn (such as HomeSpun) is best, but any kind of yarn can be used. If you would be willing to teach someone else how to knit or crochet, let Kathy Albrecht know, and she can hook you up with someone who wants to learn.
