Church Council Highlights of the January 17, 2021 Meeting:

- * All worship services in January and February will be inside because of unpredictable weather. Outside worship resumes Palm Sunday, March 28.
- * There will be one Easter Sunday Service at the Gathering Place at 9:00 am.
- * It was approved to begin gathering information for renovations for the picnic area as a special project to be completed with special offerings. All members will be given a chance to give input and make donations. Terrell Wiggins and Debbie Foster will co-chair the committee.
- * Pastor Anne's vacation weeks for 2021 were approved: April 6-14, June 8-15, August 10-17, October 12-19, December 28-Jan. 4.
- * A motion to purchase more powerful speakers for the Gathering Place was approved, with expenses not to exceed \$500. The original speakers will be returned and that amount credited towards these.
- * Special offerings were approved. For Easter the recipient will be the Food Bank of the Golden Crescent. For Easter the recipient will be the ELCA Good Gifts' Global Barnyard.
- * It was approved for the youth to collect a "Noisy Offering" the last Sunday of each month to raise money to go out beyond this congregation.
- * Elected Linda Koehler President, Brenda Bade Vice President and Debbie Foster Secretary
- * Council liaisons appointed to Committees: Brenda Bade to Outreach Committee, Lindsey Youngblood and Leslie Wunsch to Christian Education, Paul Post to Property, Regina Calhoun to Safety/Security, David Bowman to Stewardship/Finance
- * The Annual Meeting Part 2 will be on February 14, 2021 following the worship service





40 CANS/ CASH FOR 40 DAYS. As usual, we will be collecting donations for the food pantry as part of our Lenten discipline. Each member of the congregation is encouraged to bring either a non-perishable food item or at least \$1 per day for each of the 40 days of Lent, that starts on February 17 (the pantry can buy in bulk from the food bank, so the monetary donations go further). A FIRST COMMUNION CLASS will be offered on Saturday, February 20, at 9:00 am. This class is geared towards anyone 1st grade or older who wishes to share in this sacrament, and each student is required to bring at least one parent with them to the class. After the class, the parent decides whether their student is ready to participate or not. I continue to pray for God's blessings on St. Peter's as we grow as a Christian community in faith, worship and service.


