<u>Deck repair</u>—all buildings. Tools needed: cordless screw drivers, sanders, saws, hammers, tape measure, squares, gloves, knee pads, sawhorse, pump sprayer.

Retaining wall repair—A-frame. Tools needed: gloves, carpentry tools, shovel, hoe, wheel-barrow, sledge hammer, wire cutters, hacksaw, grinder.

Bluff trail maintenance- trail to the cross. Tools needed: chainsaw, bar and chain oil, fuel, gloves, proper/comfortable shoes and clothing, portable water jug, safety glasses, earplugs.
