


# **COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS from the June 18 meeting:**

- Christian Ed committee reported that AUGUST 20 is the date set for the annual SPLC at Splashway trip. Lindsey will begin collecting reservations soon so we know if we can get the group rate.
- Outreach committee announced plans for God's Work, Our Hands in September.
  On the actual weekend (Sept. 9) they are hoping to do soup kits for the food
  pantry like they did last year. Later in September our congregation will be sponsoring *Sole Mission*, a non- profit group that provides shoes free of charge to
  school age children. Council approved the \$1000 to bring them to Goliad County,
  and we will need lots of volunteers to get the word out and to work that day.
- It was voted to take the \$180 still needed to purchase an entire well from Water To Thrive from the local benevolence fund. Gerald will get in contact with them to work out a day to present our "well" to us.
- A motion from the memorial committee was approved to put \$1000 of memorials for Marilyn Morris into the picnic area renovation fund, and \$225 from her memorials to go to Katie's Fund to help provide religious education to woman.
- A motion from the memorial committee was approved to use \$1500 of memorial funds to purchase 100 copies of the new <u>All Creation Sings</u> hymnals for the pews so we don't have to use inserts and extra booklets.
- Renovation updates were given 1)The metal that was taken down is still being re -done to make it right to use. As soon as it's done they will begin construction again. 2) It will cost \$5800 to have the floors done in the kitchen, bathrooms, and beverage areas and \$4300 for the countertops in all areas. 3) The appliances have been chosen all appliances together costing approximately \$8500.
- The handicapped parking spaces are being re-done so that some of them will be wider for easier van/wheelchair access. Parking stoppers will also be added at an additional cost of \$190.
