
GOLIAD OUTREACH FOOD PANTRY

GOLIAD OUTREACH FOOD PANTRY always appreciates monetary donations, but currently the Food Bank is running short on supplies, so they cannot get the food at a deep discount like usual. We are collected non-

perishable food for our food pantry – take them directly to the pantry and leave them on the tables around back, or leave them on the desk in our fellowship hall.



ADULT BIBLE STUDY will continue meeting in the summer on the 2nd Wednesdays – June 14, July 12, and August 9. The topic is yet to be determined, but we will meet for a meal at 6:00 pm. The main dish will be provided, everyone else is asked to bring food to go with it. For June 14 the main course is chicken and rice. The Bible study itself will start about 6:45 or so.



LUTHERAN WORLD RELIEF workdays will continue through the summer months, on the third Wednesday of each month (that's June 21 this month). GATHERING PLACE CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

As construction progressed at the Gathering Place, it was noted that they were putting up a welded building, instead of the bolt-up building we wanted. Members have met with the contractor and come up with an agreement that the existing metal frame would be taken down, welded sections fixed and converted to bolt-up construction. The church will pay the additional \$8,000 for the bolt-up vs. welded structure, the contractor will cover other costs incurred. A propane tank is being procured from the Bades and will be used there contingent on its condition. Propane lines and installation will happen when construction is completed. Appliances have been selected but not yet purchased.

CHURCH COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

- ⇒ \$40 for 40 days raised \$4670. It was voted that, if the \$330 necessary to purchase and entire well haven't been donated by the end of May, we will use local benevolence to bring the total to the \$5000 needed.
- ⇒ The gutter by the front door was clogged by two balls. It has been cleaned, and leaks in the kitchen roof have been fixed.
- ⇒ The bird nest in the bell tower has been removed, but an additional screen needs to be installed.
- ⇒ Property committee is looking into the benefits and cost of purchasing and installing a water softener and replacing church faucets that have Corrosion.
