GOD'S WORK, OUR HANDS Sunday is September 10, 2023! Once again we will be putting together soup packets for the clients at the Goliad Outreach Food Pantry. We will gather in the fellowship hall right after worship and put together 175 bags of soup ingredients and seal them up with love! Many hands of all ages are needed as we use our hands to do God's work of feeding the hungry. We will also be putting together school kits for Lutheran World Relief.

This year, we will continue God's Work, Our Hands on Saturday, September 30th. We are partnering with a non-profit organization from Conroe, Texas, known as Sole Mission. Our goal for this partnership will be to distribute 250 pairs of shoes to kids of all ages in Goliad

county. The shoe distribution on the



30th will be from 9:00am-12:00noon in the Wimberly building at the Goliad County Fairgrounds.

There are no restrictions or requirements to receive a pair of shoes. The plan is to set up Friday, September 29th in the evening (time to be announced) to receive instructions and training of the distribution process. We will need about 20 volunteers to accomplish this goal, so please sign up on the sign-up sheet in the narthex by September 24th. Flyers will go out to schools by September 1st, as well as posted around town. Join us as we continue to work God's Work with Our Hands in our community!
