

# **Conference News from Sherry Sanders:**

Ever wonder what other small churches around our Bluebonnet Conference are doing? In keeping with the Southwest Texas Synod focus on storytelling, here is one about United Evangelical Lutheran Dr. Martin Luther Church in Shiner.

They have begun an exciting new curriculum called God's Play for elementary grades which is based on storytelling and discovering the wonder of the Bible stories. It comes with special training and special room setups. But the most nontraditional aspect of the ministry is that it is offered on Wednesday night, beginning at 5:30 pm with a meal, followed by classes and instruction.

According to Pastor Chris Heinold, pastor in Shiner, they appear to be meeting a need in their community due to the over 100 people in attendance on some evenings.
