ST. PETER'S FINANCIAL REPORT AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2025

But with the end of the campaign, we will also be providing for loan payments in the regular operating budget for the 2026 Ministry Fund. On Friday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, Pastor Paul Kirchner, Beverly Martin and Sherry Sanders attended a Bluebonnet Conference Outreach event at St. Luke's in Schroeder. It was a great gathering of about 20 representatives from our area congregations.

Michelle Schlenke led the meeting and had done the prep work in funding a grant of \$3,500 for the Bluebonnet Conference to use to further outreach in our individual congregations. She then called on each congregation represented to share what kinds of outreach ministries each al-

ready does. Everyone was interested in the soup kits and Sole Mission projects that St. Peter's does. Jill Wiggins was called upon to share our soup kit recipes with the other churches. Margaret Jackson led a dwelling in the word using the parable of the Good Samaritan to begin our morning and focus us on compassion for our neighbor. Rebecca Guengerich. presented a study on spiritual gifts and how The goal was to designate the grant money by the end of the session to ensure it is used. For St. Peter's, it was decided to ask for \$500 to fund the making of soup kits to be extended to increase the amount given to the food bank, as they are very popular with the clients that receive food. That money will be sent by check to St. Peter's and used accordingly.

The whole morning was inspirational, eye opening, and filled with fellowship. Great things will continue to happen at St. Peter's and in other churches in our Bluebonnet Conference!




